

Feedback Analysis

To understand and assess the expectations of students on curriculum, the institution collects feedback from the students. Every year the students evaluate the curriculum on a five point scale where the student can mark eight parameters as excellent, very good, good, satisfactory and not satisfactory. The parameters like depth, coverage, applicability, learning value, clarity and relevance of the course along with the relevance of additional source material and the extend of effort required by the students are analysed and evaluated by the students. To assure them complete trust they are not compelled to write their names on the feedback form but for the purpose of proper evaluation they have to indicate their subjects. Also, provision to add further suggestions are also given.

The feedback is analysed department-wise to get a clear understanding of the course material. The syllabi for all the UG courses were the same from the year 2013-14 to 2016-17. The following is an analysis of the consolidated data obtained from students of various departments:







Department of Botany

1. The majority of the students of the Department of Botany analysed the **depth of the course content including project work** as very good. While 28% opined that the course has the real depth and content they sought for, 23% commented that the course content has adequate depth, commenting that it is good. 9% of the students are satisfied with the depth of the course




2. While assessing the **extent of coverage of course**, 43% commented it good and 28% good and 17% excellent. 11% of the students commented that they are just satisfied with the topics covered in the course and a minority of 1% said they are dissatisfied with the areas covered under their subject.




3. **Applicability/ Relevance to real life situations**


4. Clarity and relevance of textual reading material

37% of the students found their text book and learning material very good and 25% are completely happy with the resources provided to them. 28% are of the opinion that the books and material offered are good while 9% are just satisfied with it. 1% commented that textual resources are not at all satisfied




6. Relevance of additional source material (Library)

Most of the students are happy with the additional source provided as 40% marked it excellent 32% very good and 22% good. A 5% of the students are just satisfied with the sources offered by the library, 1% are not at all happy with it.




7. Extend of effort required by the students




1. Depth of course


2. Coverage of course


3. Applicability




Based on the analysis conducted, 41% of the students found their text book and learning material excellent while 37% found the resources provided to them very good. 19% are of the opinion that the

books and material offered are good while 1% of the students are just satisfied with it. The remaining 2% commented that they are not at all satisfied with the textual sources.




6. Additional source


7. Extent of effort



1. Depth of course



commented that the content of the course is good. The remaining 1.67% are satisfied with the depth of the course.




2. Coverage of course


3. Applicability


4. Learning value




6. Additional source


7. Extent of effort



1. Depth of course


As per the feedback collected from the students on curriculum, 25% of the students commented the depth of the course as excellent. When 46.15% of the students opined that the depth of the course is very good,

21.15% commented that the content of the course is good. The remaining 7.69% are satisfied with the depth of the course.




2. Coverage of course


3. Applicability


4. Learning value


5. Clarity


6. Additional source


7. Extent of effort


Since the basic components to be studied are the same, the course is analysed to have covered almost all topics. However a suggestion to give more importance to Logistics came up.

1. Depth of the course


As per the feedback collected from the students on curriculum, 49% of the students commented the depth of the course as excellent. When 29% of the students opined that the depth of the course is very

good, 20% commented that the content of the course is good. Among the remaining students, 1% is satisfied and 1% is dissatisfied with the depth of the course.




2. Coverage of course


3. Applicability


7. Extent of effort

Considering the overall rating of the curriculum, 44% of the students found it excellent while 39% opined it as very good. 16% of the students commented that the curriculum is good.





B.Voc Fashion Technology



2. After analyzing the extent of the **coverage of course**, 80.77% of the students commented it as excellent and 19.23% of the students found it very good meeting their expectations.





50.00% of the students found their text book and learning material excellent and 46.15% are of the opinion that they are very good. Among the students 3.85% found their learning material good.










6. Extend of effort required by the students

7. Considering the **overall rating** of the curriculum, most of the students found it very good. 84.62% considered it excellent and 15.38% opined it good.




Papers like “Fashion Forecasting” and “Machinery and Equipment” are suggested to be given less emphasis and areas like Indian tradition should be given more stress.




3. Applicability/ Relevance to real life situations


4. Clarity and relevance of textual reading material


6. Relevance of additional source material (Library)


7. Extend of effort required by the students




1. Depth of course


2. Coverage of course


3. Applicability


Suggestions


1. Depth of course


Suggestions


1. Depth of course


2. Coverage of course


The syllabus is criticized for being more theoretical. Requests are made for giving more emphasis to applicability.

Feedback on Curriculum from students


1. Depth of course

When the analysis of the feedback collected from the students on their curriculum, was done, we've made a report. 
2. Coverage of course


3. Applicability


4. Learning value


5. Clarity


6. Additional source


7. Extent of effort
