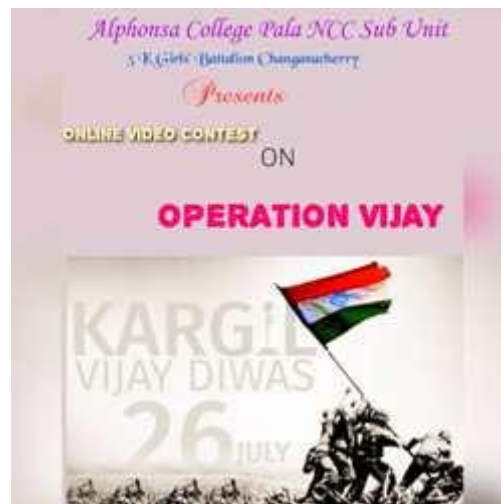


1. KARGIL VIJAY DIWAS 26 JULY 2020

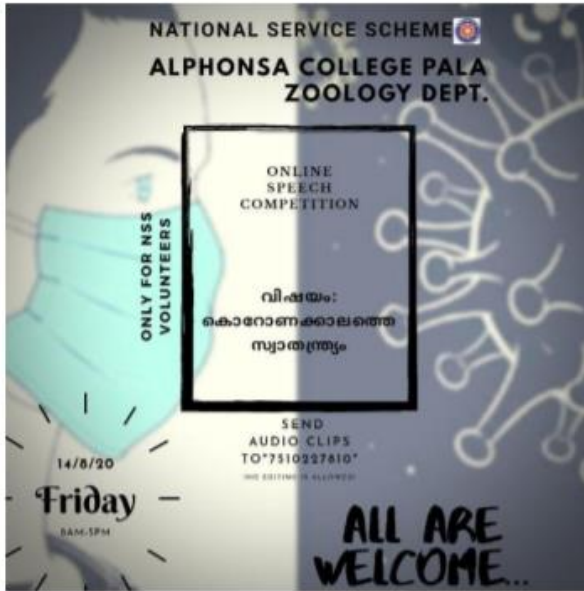
3.ATHMANIRBHARBHARAT 9TH AUGUST 2020

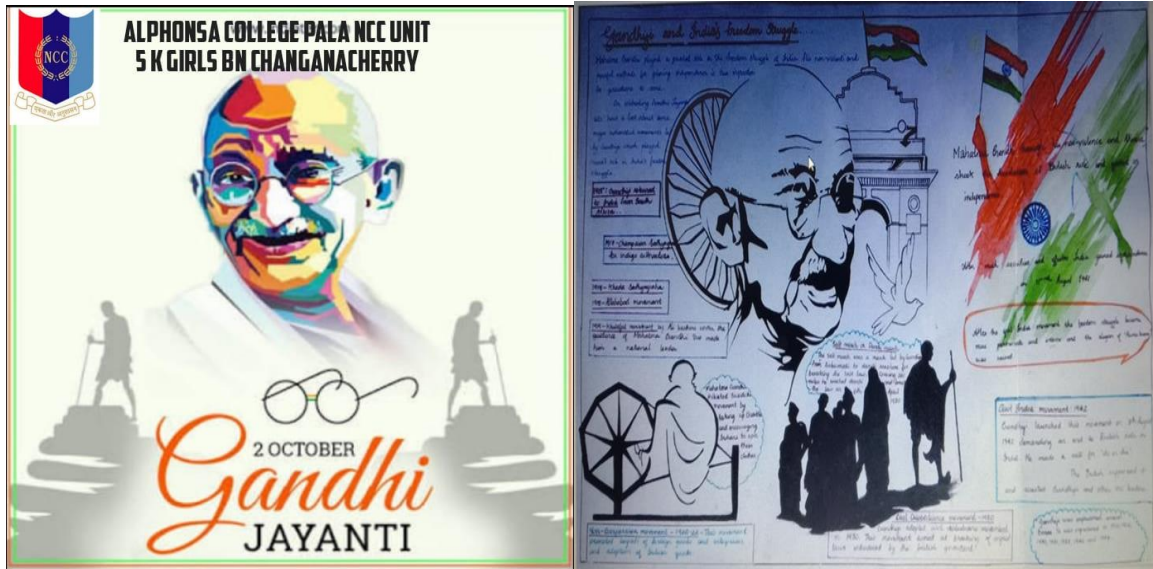


5. WOMEN EQUALITY DAY-AUGUST 26
