

Yuvajanangalil" conducted by the Kottayam District Police(Janamythri Police) as part of Police Smrithidhinam on 28th October 2021.







JUNE 5th – THE WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY






Interdepartmental collage making competition-International day against Drug abuse & trafficking.


Onappattu competition-21/8/2021


International Day against Drug abuse and Illicit trafficking held on 26 June 2021


The Physics Association conducted various competitions to create awareness against drug abuse. These include Digital Poster design, Handmade poster, Pencil drawing and Photography.



Alphonsa Day Celebration - 28 July 2021








National Science Day Celebration - 2 March 2022
